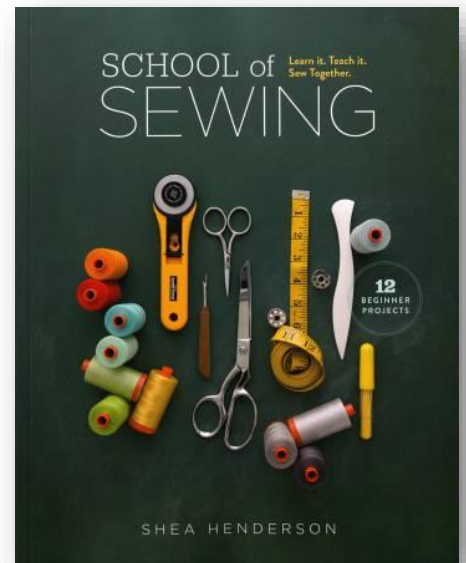


**School of Sewing with Dianne Bartek - Offered quarterly**
