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Supply List

Choosing fabric and preparing your pattern is part of the first session. Students will receive a 15% discount on pattern, fabric and notions purchased for this class.

✓ *You will not need a machine for the first class.*

Supplies:

- Fabric as indicated on pattern back – This is for the first class session. Colors are your choice.
- Scissors – both paper and fabric
- Rotary cutter and extra blades
- Add-A-Quarter Ruler 12” or 18”
- 6” X 18” ruler and medium cutting mat
- Seam Ripper
- Scotch Tape
- Fabric Glue Stick &/or Glue Pen (we like Sewline or Bohin)
- High quality cotton thread 50 or 60 weight (we like Aurifil)
- Large uncoated, non-textured paper clips (lots)
- Gallon baggies & Sharpie marker
- A few Flower Head pins
- Sewing machine in good working order with ¼” foot, power cord, foot pedal

Optional but good to have:

- Purple Thang
- Size 70/10 Microtex or Sharp needles
- Ink pen or pencil
- Personal iron and pressing surface
- 1 piece of heavy weight template plastic
