Supplies:

- Pattern from choices above
- 1-2 yards of fusible product – we like Steam-a-Seam Lite
- 1-2 yards of background (size depends on chosen pattern)
- 1-2 yards of lightweight fabric as base for applique – muslin, voile, batiste or similar or pattern tracing material
- Lots of floral prints with dense pattern. Have a good mixture of small to large scale. You will want to have lots to choose from 😊
- Marker for tracing pattern on to base fabric
- SHARP! Scissors – Carol likes the green handle ones by Karen Kay Buckley, small and sharp!
- Optional – laces, buttons and crystals for embellishing
