Choice of one pattern:

"I Brake for Cookies" by Cranberry Pie

Quilt or table runner is 13in x 31.5in. Simple back stitch embroidery is used for this humorous depiction of Santa and his reindeer flying out for the big night, keeping a look-out for cookies and milk along the way. Pieced borders.



"Days 'Till Santa Comes" by Birdbrain Designs

- 14 inches x 16 inches
- Countdown the days 'til Christmas on the Chalkboard Fabric Cloud. Happy Santa and his reindeer fly over houses on Christmas Eve heading to your house embroidered in Red Work on Snowflake cotton with a creamy tonal background. FUN for ALL Kids!

SUPPLIES:

- Your choice of pattern above
- Cosmo Floss thread kit and needle for hand embroidery
- Friction pen for tracing the design
- Background fabric
- Stabilizer for background fabric – We like Pellon Shape Flex - SF101

Bring to class:

- 6" embroidery hoop of your choice
- No sewing machines necessary for class

To finish your project – not necessary for class

- Fabric for border and backing
- Small piece of batting
