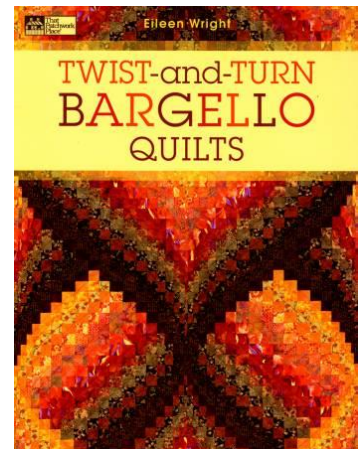


Aurora Borealis from Twist-and-Turn Bargello

This lap sized quilt is a great place to start exploring the world of Bargello quilts. We have combined a great assortment of fabrics into a kit so you don't even have to worry about picking out the fabric! Finished size about 42" X 58" with borders.

The required book – *Twist-and-Turn Bargello Quilts* is a fantastic text and contains 11 projects, color photos and complete instructions for making them from start to finish. It will be a great addition to your library and one you will turn to again and again for intriguing projects awash with color.

SUPPLY LIST

- *Twist and Turn Bargello* book by Eileen Wright (required)
- Fabric kit by Inspire! Kit includes 20 different fabrics coordinated from light to dark, all in purples and aqua. Border fabric to be purchased separately.
- Sewing machine in good working order
- Neutral piecing thread (med gray is good for this project) and wound bobbins
- Rotary cutter(with a new blade) and mat
- Rulers: 6"x 14", 6" or 9" square, Stripology ruler (very useful, but optional)
- Your personal sewing kit - scissors, seam ripper, pins, glue stick, fabric marking pens
- Sharpie, manila file folder.
- Optional: We will be doing quite a bit of pressing so a small iron and press mat would be helpful

CLASS PREWORK:

- Stabilize and press all fabrics **BEFORE** class. Best Press or starch works best for this process. Stabilizing your fabric is an important step in assuring a beautiful finished product and takes some time to do. Making sure this is done prior to the first class leaves more time for instruction.
