Supply List:

- Quiltworx pattern – ***Poinsettia***
- Your choice of fabric in quantities as directed on pattern back
- Sewing machine in good working order with ¼” foot, power cord, foot pedal
- Your personal Quiltworx tool kit:
 - Scissors – both paper and fabric
 - Rotary cutter and extra blades
 - Add-A-Quarter Ruler 12” or 18”
 - 6” X 18” ruler and medium cutting mat
 - Seam Ripper
 - Scotch Tape
 - Fabric Glue Stick &/or Glue Pen (we like Sewline or Bohin)
 - High quality cotton thread 50 or 60 weight (we like Aurifil)
- Large uncoated, non-textured paper clips (lots)
- Gallon baggies & Sharpie marker
- A few long Flower Head pins

• **Optional but good to have:**

- Purple Thang
- Size 70/10 Microtex or Sharp needles
- Ink pen or pencil
- Personal iron and pressing surface
- 1 piece of heavy weight template plastic
